TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Tournament is 36 holes, of stroke play, 18 at Orinda CC and 18 at Claremont CC open to the first 192 entries. THE ENTRY FEE IS \$395.00.

We will be using our traditional stroke-play format for the 81st Annual Championship. There will be Championship, first, second and third flights with an approximate equal number of players in each flight. Each flight will be based on the player's current index.

The Championship Prize will be awarded for Low Gross of the field. There will also be a prize for Low Net Champion of the field. Other prizes will be awarded as follows:

Championship Flight – First, Second & Third place overall Net.

First Flight – First, Second & Third place Net.

Second Flight – First, Second & Third place Net.

Third Flight – First, Second & Third place Net.

A player may not receive more than one award. In the case of a tie for the Low Gross Championship, the winner will be decided by a sudden death playoff starting on the number one hole at Claremont CC. All other ties will be decided by using USGA procedure by scorecard (based on back nine at Claremont CC). Prizes will be awarded at lunch on Tuesday at Claremont CC. The Board of Governors request that all participants stay to enjoy the luncheon at Claremont CC and the trophy presentation.

The May 15 index will be used. The Tournament Committee will arrange your foursome and will attempt to comply with specific pairing requests. **Only two members from the same club are allowed in each foursome.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The tournament fee will cover green fees, golf carts, lunch on Monday and Tuesday, breakfast on Tuesday morning and the Annual Cocktail Party and Dinner Monday evening.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Golf: Golf slacks or golf shorts with collared shirt required. Shorts are not permitted at Claremont CC.

Cocktail Party and Dinner: COAT AND TIE REQUIRED. *Blue blazer with association tie and crest is preferred.*

NON-PLAYING MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION are invited to attend the annual dinner at a cost of \$65.00. If you plan to attend, please indicate on the official entry blank and remit payment of \$65.00 to SGANC, P.O. BOX 1157, Pebble Beach, CA 93953.

GOLF CARTS ARE MANDATORY. The golf cart charge is included in the entry fee.

NON-METAL SPIKES ARE MANDATORY AT BOTH COURSES.
