## TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Tournament will be 36-hole Better Ball of partners, Low Gross and Low Net. Eighteen holes will be played Monday afternoon, and eighteen on Tuesday morning.

The maximum field of 200 players will be divided into two equal flights according to combined handicaps of each team. The lower half combined handicaps will be in the Presidents Flight; the remaining half will be in the Governors Flight. The maximum handicap spread allowed between partners is 15.0. If necessary, the higher handicap will be adjusted down. September 1 index will be used.

The tournament committee will arrange your group or will comply with your requested pairing if the enclosed entry form is returned by September 1st. Only two members from the same club are allowed in each group. Entries will be limited to 100 teams, 200 players. Entries received after the field is full will be replaced on a waiting list.

**ENTRY FEE: \$450.00/Person \$900.00/Team Deadline: September 1st**

The entry fee includes green fees, range balls and cart both days, lunch and dinner banquet on Monday with two drink tickets for cocktails; and breakfast and awards luncheon on Tuesday. The entry fee does not include spouse's dinner. The spouse's dinner must be paid in advance of the event.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

DRESS REQUIREMENTS: Golf or casual attire is appropriate at all functions. Coats and ties are not required for dinner. The tournament players must wear collared shirts & shorts must be tailored and be no more than 4" above the knee. No jeans or denim apparel. **SOFT-SPIKES OR SPIKELESS GOLF SHOES ARE REQUIRED.**

NON-PLAYING MEMBERS OR SPOUSES may attend dinner, with a payment of \$75.00. Please check appropriate box on the entry form, include your name and return in the enclosed envelope.

GOLF CARTS are mandatory during the tournament.

SPEED OF PLAY: The pace of play is fifteen (15) minutes per hole (a 4 1/2 hour pace of play program). Any group of four taking longer to play will be considered out of position and may be asked to pick up and move to the appropriate hole.

ENTRIES may be accepted after September 1st only if the field is not full and the pairings have not been finalized. Call Tom Bowden or Mary Bakan at (831) 625-4653 to determine if there is an opening.

Full refunds due to withdrawals will be granted through September 1st. After that refunds will be \$400.00.

POSTING OF SCORES: Do not post scores. Scores will automatically be posted at the end of the tournament.

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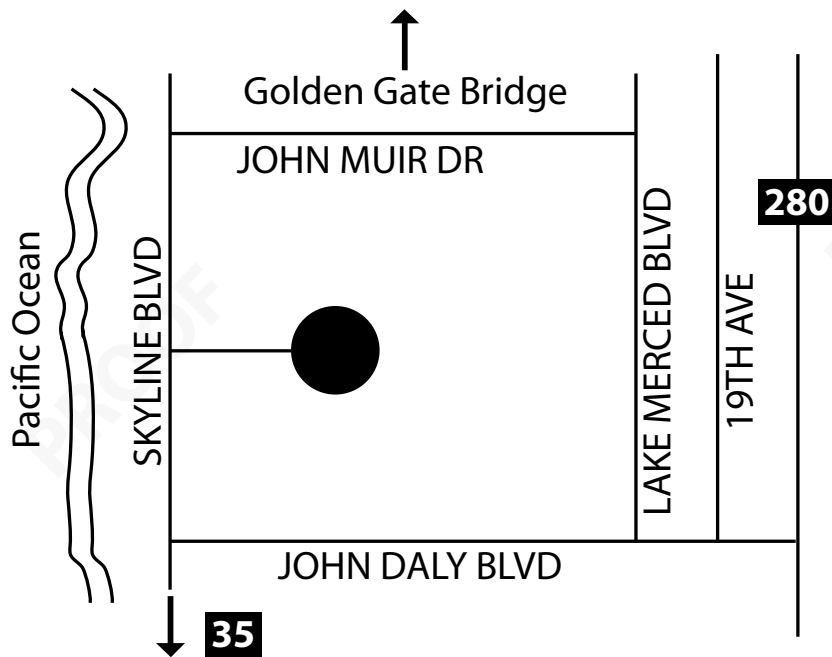
