#### **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

The Tournament is 36 holes, of stroke play at Half Moon Bay GL, with 18 on the Old Course and 18 on the Ocean Course. open to the first 192 entries. THE ENTRY FEE IS \$395.00.

We will be using our traditional stroke-play format for the 82nd Annual Championship. There will be the championship, first, second, third and fourth flights with an approximate equal number of players in each flight. Each flight will be based on the player's current index.

The championship prize will be awarded for Low Gross of the field. There will also be a prize for Low Net Champion of the field. Other prizes will be awarded as follows:

Championship Flight – First, Second & Third place overall Net.

First Flight - First, Second & Third place Net.

Second Flight - First, Second & Third place Net.

Third Flight – First, Second & Third place Net.

Fourth Flight - First, Second & Third place Net.

Last Prize - 2nd Day Low Net.

A player may not receive more than one award. In the case of a tie for the Low Gross Championship, the winner will be decided using USGA procedure by scorecard (based on back nine of the Ocean Course). Prizes will be awarded at lunch on Monday. The Board of Governors request that all participants stay to enjoy the luncheon and the trophy presentation.

The May 1 index will be used. The Tournament Committee will arrange your foursome and will attempt to comply with specific pairing requests. Only two members from the same club are allowed in each foursome.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The tournament fee will cover green fees, golf carts, lunch on Sunday and Monday, breakfast on Monday morning and the annual cocktail party and dinner Sunday evening.

#### DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Golf: Golf slacks or golf shorts with collared shirt required.

Cocktail Party and Dinner: COAT AND TIE REQUIRED. Blue blazer with association tie and crest is preferred.
