**ORIGIN OF
SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

On a cold foggy day in September, 1928, the final round of the Senior Championship tournament conducted by the Northern California Golf Association took place at the Presidio Golf Club, San Francisco.

There were sixty-three participants in the competition and upon completion of play all departed at once for their respective homes. This was during the period of Prohibition and alcoholic beverages were not available at the Club.

A group of four convened in the locker room over a bottle of Scotch, and discussed the situation. The four included John G. Sutton, Horace Guittard, J. E. (Jack) French and Brace Carter, then Secretary of the Northern California Golf Association.

The consensus of opinion was that something should be done at once to introduce a spirit of friendly congeniality among those golfers of senior age. It was then decided to form an association comprised of senior golfers and at once a committee comprised of a dozen senior members of different clubs in Northern California was appointed to contact members of their clubs who were eligible in age-originally fifty years minimum.

The enthusiastic reception was unbelievable and in less than three months three hundred applicants were on the roster.

The initial tournament and organization dinner took place in August, 1929 at the Burlingame Country Club. Two hundred and thirty competed in the tournament and attended the dinner at which time a constitution and by-laws were adopted. John G. Sutton was unanimously elected to the office of President and the organization was on its way with flying colors!

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

The SGANC has completed the 1900's in fine status with money in the bank and a healthy expanded waiting list as we continue to move forward with our plans to attract future members from new and/or "under represented clubs".

It was a pleasure to have the championship tournament return to Orinda and Claremont Country Clubs after 20 years. In fact the return to those courses proved to be very beneficial to our first time gross and net champions. Bob Callan of The Olympic Club, a first year member, shot a two under par 138 to win. He had played Orinda many times and until a few years ago held the competitive course record of 65. The net championship went to Jim Kelly of Claremont who shot six under net each day to walk away from the field with a 128, a nine stroke winner. Congratulations to both for their first championships.

The four-ball tournament at Auburn Valley Country Club also was very successful. The location attracted more entries than the 128 that could be accommodated and was played in beautiful weather. This event also resulted in first time winners with Harvey Kohs and Jim Sullivan of Pasatiempo winning the tie-breaker from two-time defending champions, Jim McMurtrey and Bill Celli; both shot 137. The net winners were Charlie Quinn and Don Ridge of San Jose Country Club with a 127.

At the NCGA Annual Meeting in October, Vice President Gordon Scott presented a check for \$5,455.00 to Gary Vandeweghe, Chairman of the NCGA Foundation (also a SGANC member) to be used in support of junior golf. This amount comes from our dues and additional gifts by members and is one of the largest single independent contributions that the Foundation receives.

At the October Board of Governors meeting, the board approved two changes to the by-laws: A restructuring of the officer positions to match them with their regularly assigned duties, and setting forth a procedure to fill vacancies on the Board as a result of mid-term resignations. The By-laws had not covered this situation and yet we have had four such resignations in the past four years.



On behalf of the membership and the Governors, I express our thanks to the three retiring Governors: Dick Graffis, Jim McMurtrey and Don Riess. They all have been very active in all phases of the association's activities and they will be missed.

I personally express my thanks to our officers and Governors for their untiring efforts on behalf of the members of this organization. Our tournaments would not occur without such efforts. I also add a special thanks to our Assistant Secretary-Treasurer, Christine Frost. She is the person that keeps us going, and I dropped the ball at the Annual Meeting by not even introducing her. With these words, I give her a "standing ovation" for a job well done.

I have enjoyed serving on the Board and as your President this past year. I wish the best to your new President, Gordon Scott, his officers and board members who are taking our championship to the Fresno area for the first time. On to 2000 . . .

SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA BYLAWS

ARTICLE I

Name

SECTION 1. This Association shall be called SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA.

ARTICLE II

Objectives

SECTION 1. The Objectives of this Association are to encourage friendly competition in golf among senior players residing in Northern California and to hold an annual golf tournament at such clubs situated in Northern California as shall be approved to the Board of Governors. Other tournaments may be held if approved by the Board of Governors.

SECTION 2.

(a) This organization does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and is organized for nonprofit purposes.

(b) Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this association shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the specific purposes of the association.

(c) If this organization holds any event(s) which members of the general public are invited to observe or participate in for a fee, the income from the general public, less a proportional share of the expenses which will not benefit members, will be paid over to an organization which is exempt from income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code on an annual basis.

ARTICLE III

Officers

SECTION 1. The officers shall be a president, first vice-president, second vice-president, and secretary-treasurer, all to be elected at an annual meeting of the Association. The position of assistant secretary-treasurer may be filled, if necessary, by a nonmember of the Association chosen by the Board of Governors.

SECTION 2. There shall be a Board of Governors of eighteen members. At each annual meeting six members shall be elected to take the place of members whose terms then expire.

The Executive Committee of the Association shall be composed of the four elected officers. They shall have all the powers of the Board of Governors when the Board is not in session.

SECTION 3. Governors and Officers shall assume the duties of their respective positions on January 1 of the year immediately following their election and serve until replaced. All Officers are part of the 18 member Board.

ARTICLE IV

Duties of Officers

SECTION 1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association and of the Board of Governors, and report any matter which, in his judgment, may be important of benefit to the Association. He shall be ex-officio a member of all committees and shall have the power to fill vacancies by appointment.

SECTION 2. The First Vice-President shall, in the event of absence, death, or physical disability of the President, act in his stead in all matters; and in case of absence, death, or physical disability of both the President and the First Vice-President, the Second Vice-President shall act in their stead.

SECTION 3. The Secretary-Treasurer shall have charge of the funds of the Association, and deposit them at such bank as the President may direct. He shall pay bills when duly approved by the President and Chairman of the Tournament Committee, and present an annual statement of the receipts and expenditures of the Association at each annual meeting.

The Secretary-Treasurer shall attend to the correspondence of the Association and keep the minutes of the meetings and shall furnish the names of applicants for membership to the Chairman of the Membership Committee. He shall mail and collect all bills for dues, initiation fees and other charges as approved by the Board of Governors. The Secretary-Treasurer may assign such of his duties to the Assistant Secretary-Treasurer as he deems proper. The Assistant Secretary-Treasurer shall assist the President and all other officers and committee chairmen in the performance of their duties.

ARTICLE V

Meetings

SECTION 1. The Annual Meeting and dinner for the transaction of business and the election of officers and members of the Board of Governors shall be held on an evening of one of the days of the Annual Tournament; such day to be designated in advance by the President.

SECTION 2. Members of the Association present at the annual or Special Meeting of the Association shall constitute a quorum.

SECTION 3. The order of business shall be:

1. Reading of the Minutes.
2. Report of the President.
3. Report of the Treasurer.
4. Reports of Committees.
5. Unfinished business.
6. New business.
7. Election of officers and Board.

SECTION 4. A special meeting of the Board may be called by the President, or any officer, at any time. Any number of Governors present may constitute a quorum.

BYLAWS (continued)

SECTION 5. The Board of Governors shall hold its Annual Meeting on one of the days of the Annual Tournament such time and day to be designated by the President for conduct of any business that may come before it. Newly nominated Board members may be invited to attend.

ARTICLE VI

Membership

SECTION 1. Any man who has reached the age of fifty-five years, and is a member in good standing of a Regular Member golf club which is a member of the Northern California Golf Association, is eligible for membership. He must be invited and proposed in writing by a member, seconded by another member, and his proposer and seconder must each write a letter to the Secretary of the Association stating his qualifications for membership in the Association. An applicant may file an application for membership at age 50, however, he shall not be eligible for membership until he reaches 55 years of age.

SECTION 2. When an approved applicant has been notified of his election and he does not accept within ten days, the Secretary will then contact the proposer to determine status. If the applicant has good reason for not accepting and if it is his desire to remain on the waiting list, he then will be placed at the top of the list for the following year; otherwise his name will be dropped.

SECTION 3. Any member may be expelled by the Board of Governors after notice to him of the charges against him, and due opportunity to be heard given him.

SECTION 4. The Classes of membership in the Association shall be as follows.

(a) REGULAR membership shall be limited to three hundred. The number of REGULAR members from any one CLUB shall not exceed 10% of the current Regular membership of the Association

(b) Non-Playing Members are Voluntary or Involuntary, as follows:

(1) Voluntary Non-Playing Members are former Regular Members who request and receive Non-playing status for a reason acceptable to the Board of Governors.

(2) Involuntary Non-Playing Members are former Regular Members who have not played in the Annual Championship for two consecutive years and have not requested, in writing, an exemption. However, if a Member cannot play in the Annual Championship, for a reason acceptable to the Board, he may be granted a one year exemption. The request for exemption must be presented to the Board, in writing, prior to the Tournament.

(3) Voluntary and Involuntary Members may apply for reinstatement as Regular Members, at any time, and upon approval of their applications by the Board of Governors, shall be placed at the head of the waiting list. Voluntary Non-Playing Members may play in the first Annual Championship Tournament following reinstatement; Involuntary Non-Playing Members may not play until the second

Annual Championship Tournament following reinstatement.

(c) HONORARY MEMBERS: The President of the United States or any other distinguished senior may, by vote of the Board of Governors, be elected an Honorary Member of the Association. An Honorary Member shall be exempt from initiation fees and dues.

(d) HONORARY LIFE MEMBERS: All Past Presidents shall be Honorary Life Members and shall be exempt from payment of dues, but shall pay an entry fee for any tournament he enters.

(e) MEMBERS EMERITUS: Members of the Association who shall attain the age of eighty years, and who have a record of continuous membership of more than five (5) years, shall be Members Emeritus and shall be exempt from payment of dues, but shall pay an entry fee for any tournament he enters.

SECTION 5. Membership in the Association shall be classified for tournament play as follows:

Age 55 to 59 inclusive - Class D

Age 60 to 64 inclusive - Class C

Age 65 to 69 inclusive - Class B

Age 70 to 74 inclusive - Class A

Age 75 to 79 inclusive - Class AA

Age 80 and over - Class AAA

These age groups shall be modified by adjustment upward or downward each year to provide for approximately the same number of players in each flight.

ARTICLE VII

Membership Committee

SECTION 1. There shall be a Membership Committee (to be anonymous) which shall consist of three members to be appointed by the president. No applicant shall be elected a member of the Association except (1) upon the affirmative vote of the committee or a majority thereof, and (2) upon approval by the Board of Governors.

SECTION 2. The Membership Committee shall take up and pass upon applications for membership and recommend approval to the Board of Governors. The applications shall be approved in the order in which they are received, subject to the provisions of Article VI, Section 4 (a). Following Board approval, the applicants will be designated "approved applicants" on the chronological listing.

The Membership Committee may, with the approval of the Board, each year consider and recommend for Membership out of the order in which the application is received not more than two applicants per year who in the opinion of the Committee have over a period of years made an outstanding contribution to the game of golf.

SECTION 3. A meeting of the Membership Committee may be held at any time upon the call of the Chairman of the Committee, and the vote of any absent member upon an application for membership may be made and taken by mail, telegraph or telephone.

BYLAWS (continued)

ARTICLE VIII

Initiation Fee and Dues

SECTION 1. The Initiation fee and annual dues shall be set yearly by the Board of Governors, payable on December 1 of each year, or, in the case of a new member, upon his election; provided, however, that a Non-playing member may retain his membership upon payment of one-half the regular membership dues.

SECTION 2. Any member whose annual dues remain unpaid on the fifteenth of January shall cease to be a member and his name shall be dropped from the roll at the next annual meeting. Delinquents may be reinstated as a member only upon election in due form and the payment of the initiation fee and the annual dues currently set by the Board of Governors.

ARTICLE IX

Tournaments

SECTION 1. The Association shall hold an Annual Championship Tournament at one or more golf courses located in Northern California each year, at a time to be designated by the Tournament Committee. An entry fee shall be charged for participation in the Tournament and the amount shall be set annually by the Tournament Committee with Board approval.

The member making the lowest gross score for thirty-six holes in the two-day play shall be the winner of the Annual Tournament, and designated as Senior Champion for that year.

SECTION 2. Other tournaments may be held if approved by the Board of Governors.

ARTICLE X

Tournament Committee

SECTION 1. The management of the Annual Championship Tournament of the Association, and any other tournaments, shall be in the hands of a Tournament Committee appointed by the President. The Tournament Committee shall have entire charge of the program and conduct of the tournament, and have full authority to purchase all prizes. It shall be the final arbiter in all complaints and appeals pertaining to the tournament or players therein, and its decision shall be final. It shall have authority to enter into any arrangement and incur any expense necessary for the conduct of the Annual Tournament.

ARTICLE XI

Nominating Committee

SECTION 1. The Nominating Committee of five members shall be appointed by the President sixty days prior to each annual meeting, and the committee shall nominate a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Secretary-Treasurer, six Governors. Other candidates may be placed in nomination at any annual meeting, upon written request to the Board of

Governors, signed by fifteen members of the Association, providing the Secretary has been notified in writing the names of the candidates fifteen days before the annual meeting.

ARTICLE XII

Non-Acceptance of Trophies

SECTION 1. The Association shall not accept from any individual, firm or corporation any prize or trophy to be competed for in any of its tournaments, except as may be provided in the event of team matches.

ARTICLE XIII

Team Competition

SECTION 1. In the event of team or teams of this Association competing with those of another similar Senior Association, the President shall appoint a team captain and such captain shall have sole authority to select and appoint the members of the team or teams.

SECTION 2. The Tournament Committee shall have full authority to represent this Association in arranging the details of team matches, the time of holding same and the conditions of play. The matching of individual players shall, however, devolve upon the captain of the team. The captain does not necessarily play on the team.

ARTICLE XIV

Guests

SECTION 1. The President may invite any non-member of the Association to participate in any Tournament and Dinner as guest of the Association, without payment of fees.

ARTICLE XV

Amendments

SECTION 1. The forgoing Bylaws may be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the Board of Governors at any time, and such vote may be made by mail.
