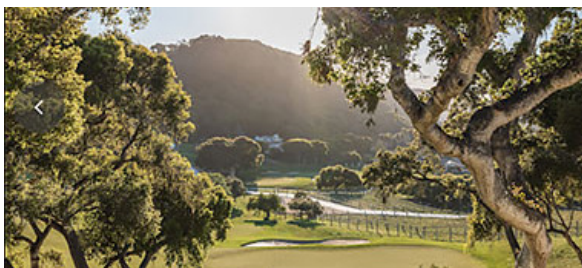




Corral de Tierra Golf Club

TOURNAMENT ENTRY FEE

The entry fee includes green fees, range balls and cart both days. Monday includes lunch, two drink tickets for the cocktail party and dinner. The entry fee also includes Tuesday's breakfast buffet and awards luncheon. The entry fee does not include a spouse's dinner which must be paid in advance of the event.



Tournament Format

The tournament will be 36-holes of partner better ball, both low gross and low net. There will be 18 holes of golf Monday and 18 holes Tuesday morning.

The maximum field of 120 players will be divided into three equal flights according to the combined handicaps of each team. There will be three flights: Championship, Presidents and Governors.

September 15 indexes will be used. All flights will use **Gross/Net Stroke Play Scoring.**

The tournament committee will arrange your group or will comply with your requested pairing if the enclosed entry form is returned by September 9. Only two members from the same club are allowed in each group. Entries will be limited to 60 teams, 120 players. Entries received after the field is full will be placed on a waiting list.

There will be an option for players to compete from shorter yardages with adjusted handicaps. Please check the Director Tee box on the entry form if you wish to play from shorter yardage.

Dress Requirements: Golf attire is appropriate at all functions. Coats and ties are not required for dinner. Non-playing members or spouses may attend dinner with a payment of \$85. Please check the appropriate box on the entry form, include your name and return in the enclosed envelope.

Speed of Play: The pace of play is 15 minutes per hole. Any group of four taking longer will be considered out of position and may be asked to pick up and move to the appropriate hole. Golf carts are mandatory during the tournament.

Posting of Scores: Do **not** post scores. Scores will automatically be posted at the end of the tournament.

Refunds: Full refunds due to withdrawals minus an administrative fee will be granted thru September 9. After that refunds will be determined by our deadline agreements with the golf clubs.
