TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Tournament is 36 holes of stroke play with 18 at Fort Washington Golf & Country Club each day. Open to the first 120 entries. **THE ENTRY FEE IS \$350.**

We will be using our traditional stroke-play format for the 93rd Annual Championship. All flights will use Gross/Net Stroke Play scoring. There will be the Championship, President's, Governor's and Director's Four-Ball flights with an approximate equal number of players in each flight. Each flight will be based on the player's current index, except the Director's Flight.

Pace of play is very important to ensure that all our members have an excellent tournament experience. Course Marshals will warn a group when they are out of position and if that group does not work its way back into position in a reasonable time, the group will be asked to pick up their ball with a Stableford score of zero and move on to the next tee.

The Championship prize will be awarded to Low Gross of the field. There will also be a prize for Low Net Champion of the field. Other prizes will be awarded as follows:

Championship Flight - Low Gross, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net
President's Flight - Low Gross, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net
Governor's Flight - Low Gross, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net
Director's Four-Ball Flight - Low Gross, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net

The Director's Flight is optional not mandatory. It supports the USGA and PGA supported program of "Playing it Forward" for enjoyment. If you wish to compete in the Director's Flight please check the box indicated on your entry form, otherwise you will be placed in a Flight suitable for your handicap index.

A Player may not receive more than one award. In the case of a tie, the winner will be decided using USGA procedure by scorecard playoff. Prizes will be awarded at lunch on Tuesday. The Board of Governors request that all participants stay to enjoy the luncheon and the trophy presentation.

The April 1st index will be used. The Tournament Committee will arrange the pairings each day, and on day one will attempt to comply with specific pairing requests. **Only two members from the same club are allowed in each group.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The tournament fee will cover green fees, carts, and range balls for both days as well as lunch and dinner Monday and the breakfast and awards luncheon on Tuesday.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Golf: Golf slacks or golf shorts with collared shirt required.

Cocktail party and Dinner: Golf Attire.

WITHDRAWALS: Full refunds less a \$20 handling fee will be honored through Friday, April 10th. After April 10th entry fees will not be refunded.

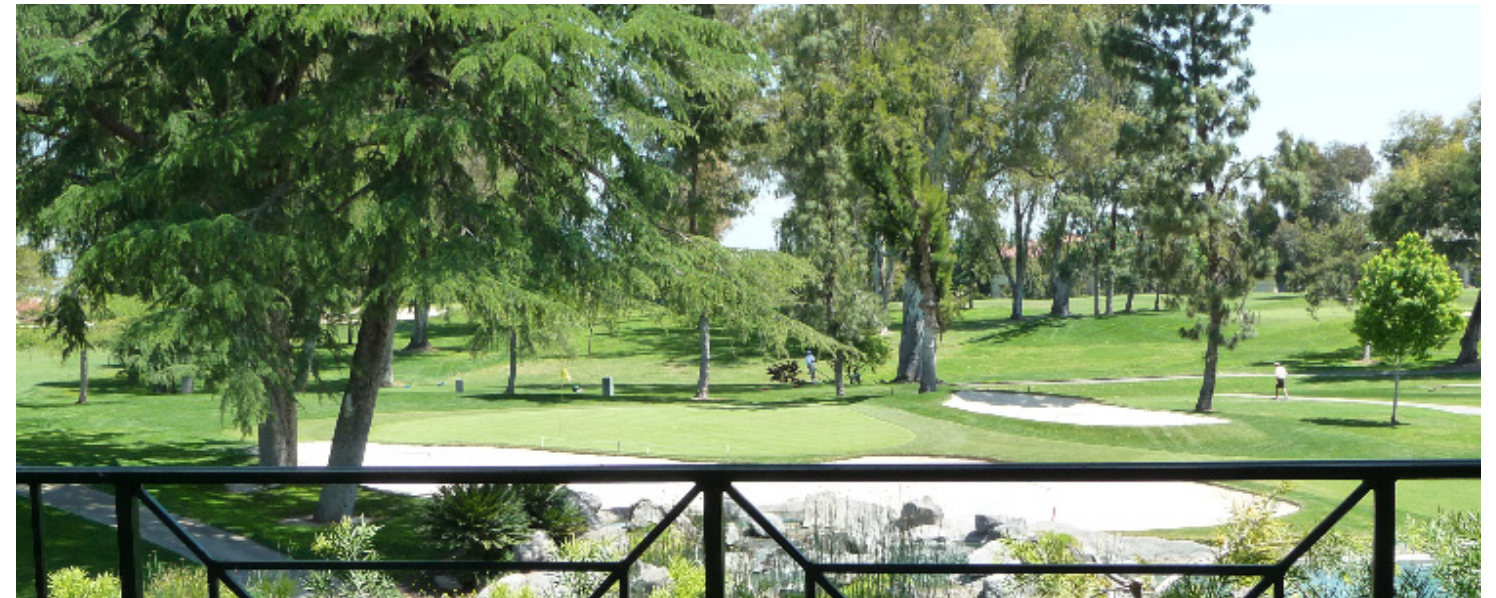
